

Q49 - Do you think that Corona has made this semester more challenging for you?





Q63 - Will the pandemic change your graduation timeline?




Q65 - Do you like the idea of a virtual (Zoom like) component to online classes? That is, classes that were always supposed to be online.

Q55 - Has the pandemic changed what you expect from an Online class?




If so, in what way?

- I expect more instruction less teach yourselves



Q104 - Do you think that Covid may change your graduation timeline?



Q49 - How worried are you that COVID will negatively impact this semester for you here




