Touch Panel

Use the touch panel to turn the system on/off, control the source, adjust volume, and in many cases adjust lighting and camera.



Laptop HDMI

Teaching consoles are equipped with a full-sized HDMI connection for your laptop.

*Please bring an adapter if your laptop does not have this connection type.



Document Camera

Used for presentation of documents or small objects. Models vary across campus.



Webcam

Classrooms are equipped with a webcam. OIR is working to install wall mounted pan/tilt/zoom cameras in each room.

Lapel mic

Used for instructor voice amplification in many classrooms. Can also be used with Zoom/Teams for online attendees.



PZM table mic

Used for Zoom/Teams online attendees. Will pick up all audio in the room. Does not amplify voice over room speakers.




USB hub

Connect USB devices when using the in-room computer.



Assistive Listening system

Amplifies mic audio to a receiver that students can obtain from Student Accessibility Services.




Duplicate or Extend the PC Screen
